

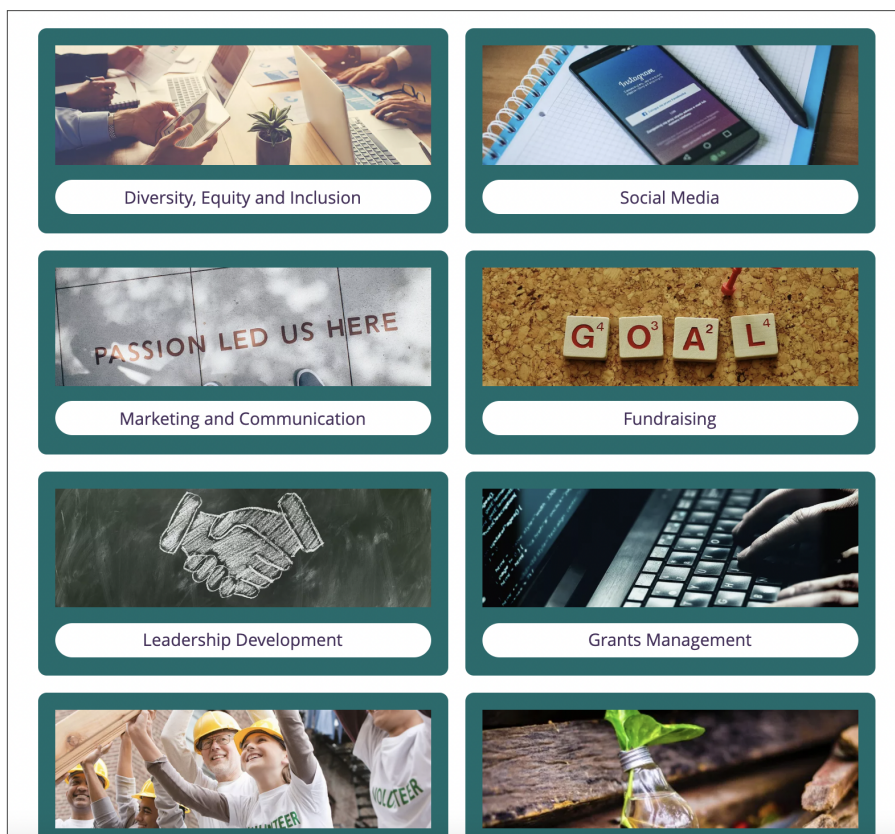
## How to Use The Nonprofit Resource Library, a professionally created and curated library of recorded webinars and downloadable resources.

Nonprofit Learning Lab's website.




To begin, in the menu at the top of nonprofit learning lab's website, click the tab  
"Nonprofit Library."

Then, scroll down the page till you come to a list of nonprofit management topics,  
Like Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion and Social Media.



Browse these topic categories, and when you find one that peaks your interest, click on the name of that category.


